

**WFPS SCHOLARSHIP FUND RULES
FOR THE
ACADEMIC YEAR
OF
(FALL 2008-SPRING 2009)
revised January 1, 2008**

ELIGIBLE STUDENTS

Applicants must be undergraduates who have successfully completed at least two years of undergraduate study, towards a four year program leading to a Bachelor degree in the Land Surveying profession. The applicants must have Junior or Senior standing in the next academic school year. Community college applicants must have the intention of transferring to an eligible four year school. Applicants must have the intention of taking the NCEE Fundamentals of Land Surveying exam.

ELIGIBLE INSTITUTIONS

Eligible institutions include any public or private, generally accredited colleges with a curriculum leading to a four year bachelor's degree with a land surveying major. The college must be in the western 13 states that are members of the Western Federation of Professional Surveyors, Inc. (WFPS). Member states are: Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, Oregon, Utah, Washington and Wyoming.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Up to \$7,200 is available and is based on the number and quality of the applications. WFPS intends to award at least two each \$1,200 scholarships in each academic year if there are qualified applicants. If there are more highly qualified applicants they may receive more or if there are several qualified applicants, more scholarships will be awarded.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Interested persons may apply by completing the WFPS application form available through the college or from: Paul A. Reid, WFPS Scholarship Chairman, 1533 Pinion Drive, Cheyenne, WY or from the www.wfps.org web site. All materials must be received by March 31, 2008 to be considered for an award in the following next academic school year. The completed application form must be accompanied by:

- 1. Completed WFPS Scholarship Application*
- 2. Transcript of all college work up to the past 3 years.*
- 3. One letter of recommendation from a college professor or a past employer.*
- 4. A one page, double spaced, typed essay from the applicant specifying: a.) Educational goals b.) Career goals and c.) Why their qualifications justify them receiving the scholarship.*

SELECTION

Applicants shall be ranked by the WFPS Scholarship Committee to their level of academic, professional qualifications, achievements, quality and neatness of their essay. The rank order list shall be forwarded onto the WFPS Board of Directors for confirmation of the recipients and amount of scholarship awarded. Alternate recipients may be selected in the event that the selected recipients are unable to accept the award.

AWARD NOTIFICATION

The Scholarship Committee Chairman will send the recipients a notice of award specifying the terms of the award. The recipients shall return the scholarship notice of award acknowledging the terms.

TIME PERIOD FOR ELIGIBILITY

The awards shall be for the period of one academic year. Students applying for the renewal of the scholarship will be considered on the same basis as first time applicants.

DISBURSEMENTS

Upon verification of registration for full-time enrollment each term, checks in the name of the recipient will be issued in substantially equal disbursements for each academic term/semester and sent to the recipient.

INVESTMENT OF THE FUND

As funds are received by WFPS for the scholarship fund, they are deposited into the principle which is then invested. Income from the investments are available to fund the scholarships each year. The amount of the scholarships available each year can vary depending on the income generated by the fund and other donations to the annual scholarships. The funds principle will not be used to pay annual scholarships.

PUBLICITY

Annually the Scholarship Committee will provide all eligible institutions a notice of the WFPS scholarship program, including rules and application forms. When the recipient has accepted the scholarship, the committee can provide appropriate publicity to the WFPS, state and local survey societies, and the college. The recipients agree to allowing their names to be released by applying for this scholarship.
